

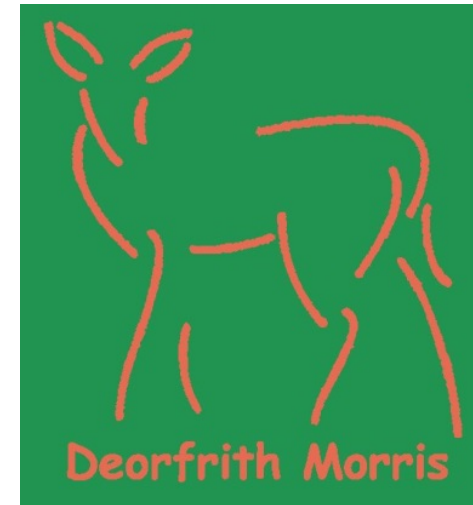
Deorfrith Morris
